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#### **Budget 2026 – Financial Context**

The Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage has determined the period from 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025 to 28<sup>th</sup> November 2025 as the prescribed period for Local Authorities to hold the 2026 Budget Meeting as per Circular Fin 10/2025. The Statutory Budget Meeting will be held on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025.

Leitrim County Council will receive a total Local Property Tax (LPT) allocation of €10,978,059 for 2026, as notified by the Department in Circular Fin 12/2025. The decision was made at the Council Meeting on the 7<sup>th</sup> of July 2025 to vary the LPT adjustment factor upwards by 15% for 2026.

In line with the provisions of Section 9 of the Local Government Rates and Other Matters Act 2019 and SI No 348 of 2024, Budget 2026 proposes the continuation of the existing abatement scheme in respect of vacant properties, whereby Leitrim County Council will grant a maximum write off equivalent to 75% of commercial rates invoiced during 2026.

In mid-2022 the "Framework for Future Delivery of Water Services" was published which provided the roadmap for the transition of water services to Irish Water during 2023. In September 2023, the Water Services function in Leitrim, transitioned to Uisce Eireann in line with the provisions of a sectoral master agreement. In this context, the budget is prepared on the basis that the cost of remaining Local Authority staff (now under the direction and control of Uisce Eireann) will be recouped directly from Uisce Eireann. Central Management Charge previously recovered from Uisce Eireann will also be substantially recouped from Central Government until the end of 2026. It is essential that such ongoing costs are recognised beyond 2026 and funded by Central Government as part of a permanent financial work out.

#### Municipal Districts – General Municipal Allocation (GMA) and Draft Budgetary Plan

The GMA and Draft Budgetary Plan were considered and adopted by the three Municipal Districts at the following meetings:


#### **Budget Drivers 2026**

The draft budget as presented has regard to the following service delivery and cost drivers:

- Capital Investment Programme: Provision has been made to meet the Councils projected match funding requirements of the six-year capital investment programme through ring fenced commercial rates and LPT increases. The Capital Investment Programme presented as part of the Budget Meeting reflects the continued delivery of an ambitious investment programme over the next 6 years. This programme provides the Council with the opportunity to maximise the potential of the expected strong economic situation nationally and the anticipated ongoing commitment to fund opportunities that will continue to be very impactful for the County, particularly Urban and Rural Regeneration Development Funds.
- **Retained Fire Service Pay Agreement:** Additional expenditure in the fire service has been provided on the basis of substantial recoupment from Central Government.
- Budget 2026 will continue to support the Housing Capital Delivery programme.

# Principle Service Costs included in Budget 2026

Budget 2026 provides for a total expenditure of €64m. This represents an increase of over 6.5% on budgeted expenditure for 2025. The following table shows the distribution of this increased expenditure by service division level.

## **Budget 2026 highlights**

- The rent review process that commenced in 2025 will continue in 2026 with the development of a new Differential Rent Scheme.
- The Vacant Homes Refurbishment Grant continues to bring derelict and vacant properties back into productive use revitalizing our towns and villages, with expenditure of €4,000,000 annually.
- Providing energy efficient homes for our housing tenants is a key priority and expenditure of €700,000 is budgeted for 2026 to achieve this goal.

- The Housing section is committed to the improvement of its Housing Stock with €133,600 budgeted in 2026 for planned maintenance informed by the Stock Condition surveys recently completed.
- Budget 2026 will continue to assist the elderly and disabled to undertake necessary improvement works to extend the useful life of their homes.
- The Local Roads funding has increased by 3% in Budget 2026, highlighting the importance attached to maintaining and improving our local road network and building on an 8% increase in the 2025 budget.
- Planning Control includes a 10% increase arising from the strengthening of staff resources in the development management area supported by the Department of Housing Local Government and Heritage. County Leitrim now has a complete up to date suite of legislatively required forward planning documents following the completion of the Carrick-on-Shannon Joint Local Area Plan 2025-2031. A variation to the County Development Plan 2023-2029 will seek to increase the quantum of lands zoned for housing purposes and will be completed in 2026.
- 2026 will see the investment in an integrated CRM platform to streamline citizen
  engagement and service delivery across all departments. The provision of online
  services will allow customers to apply, report and pay for council services online. The
  solution will enable data-driven insights and automation within CRM to improve
  responsiveness, transparency, and overall user experience. This solution empowers
  Leitrim County Council to align closely to the connecting Government 2030 directive.
- Budget 2026 includes provision to enable the continued investment in strengthening the Leitrim Tourism brand by incorporating Slow Tourism as a core theme.
- Leitrim County Council will invest in targeted PR campaigns to effectively communicate the many new developments in tourism across the county, to include, promotion of the new innovative Visitor App, to enhance the visitor experience and engagement.
- The budget will allow us to explore creative and innovative marketing strategies to showcase Leitrim as a must-visit destination.
- Budget 2026 makes provision to support potential projects such as the holding of Leitrim Business Summit event, the development of the Leitrim Diaspora Strategy and a county-wide Festival Strategy.
- The development of the Leitrim Economic and Skills Strategy is a key action under the work programme of the Leitrim Economic Forum, designed to deliver on the goals and priorities of the Leitrim Economic and Community Plan (LECP). The combined Economic and Skills Strategy will assess Leitrim's economic structure and performance, identify priority sectors for growth, analyse current and future skills demand and supply, and propose a joined-up roadmap ensuring that Leitrim's people, places and enterprises are equipped for a dynamic future economy.
- Budget 2026 makes provision to support the preparation of a new heritage plan and the increased delivery of heritage and biodiversity projects.
- Budget 2026 includes a 3% increase for the Upkeep of Parks, Pitches and Open Spaces acknowledging the importance of the upkeep and appearance of our amenities and opens spaces.
- The overall operation of the Civic Amenity Sites will be reviewed in 2026 in light of the requirements of the National Waste Management Plan for a Circular Economy 2024 – 2030.

- Leitrim County Council will continue to implement the 206 no actions contained in the
  Climate Action Plan in collaboration with the CARO and all other stakeholders. 2026
  will see particular emphasis on the retrofit of public lighting, fleet management and
  the ongoing engagement by Leitrim County Council in the pathfinder project in
  collaboration with Cavan, Monaghan, CARO and SEAI. The national ZEVI (Zero
  Emission Vehicle Ireland) projects overall goal is to increase EV charging accessibility
  and encourage the transition to zero-emission transport throughout the county. This
  will be championed in 2026 by a ZEVI coordinator position within the local authority.
- 2026 will see a continued commitment to water quality and environmental protection, with additional staff recently recruited in the area of Farm Inspections. A new River Basin Management Planning process is approaching completion, and it is anticipated that implementation will commence in 2026.
- Budget 2026 provides for additional expenditure in the fire service based upon substantial recoupment from Central Government to fund the Retained Firefighter Pay Agreement, including additional non pay costs.
- Budget 2026 will maintain the focus on town renewal, town teams, town regeneration facilitation and capital investment. Additional resources are being made available to tackle dereliction in 2026.
- Leitrim County Council will continue the rollout of the Community Safety Partnership and the Local Authority Integration Team (LAIT) in 2026, alongside ongoing support for Comhairle na nÓg, Age Friendly Leitrim, Pride of Place, and the Love Where You Live Awards – strengthening community engagement and wellbeing across the county.
- In 2026, the Local Enterprise Office (LEO) will continue to play a pivotal role in supporting micro-enterprises and fostering entrepreneurship across the county. Budget 2026 will enable the delivery of targeted supports including financial assistance, mentoring, training, and networking opportunities for start-ups and small businesses. In 2026, the LEO will prioritise initiatives directed towards enhancing digital transformation, green business practices and innovation among Leitrim SMEs.
- In 2026, Leitrim County Council will continue to invest in the development of library services as inclusive, multifunctional, and community-focused spaces. Budget 2026 will support improvements to both library services and physical infrastructure, ensuring buildings are more accessible to all users. This includes upgrades to library signage, internal layouts, and facilities to better accommodate individuals with disabilities, older adults and those with diverse needs.
- Budget 2026 will continue to develop and deliver age-friendly programmes and environments, supporting older members of the community to remain active, engaged and connected.
- Libraries will play a central role in equipping individuals with essential life skills through workshops, classes, and access to learning resources. These initiatives will support digital literacy, lifelong learning, and personal development across all age groups.

#### Provisional Local Property Tax Allocations 2026 – Leitrim County Council

A Chara,

I am directed by the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage to inform you that the provisional Local Property Tax (LPT) allocations from the Local Government Fund for 2026 have been agreed and Leitrim County Council's allocation is set out below and in **Appendix A** to this document. This approach differs from previous years given that a revaluation of LPT will take place later this year, which will lead to changes in both the overall LPT yield and to the yield in each local authority area.

LPT allocations have been calculated based on an estimated yield (pre variation) for the 2026 LPT liability year of €601.5m, based on data regarding 2025 LPT liabilities (including deferrals) as provided by the Revenue Commissioners, adjusted for newly liable properties in 2026 and including an estimated €42m arising from the 2026 revaluation process (as set out in **Appendix B** to this document).

#### **LPT Baseline and Distribution Methodology**

Under the current LPT allocation model, every local authority is entitled to receive a minimum amount of funding under the LPT allocation process, known as the Baseline. Following a review of LPT Baselines in 2023, local authority Baselines were increased overall to €428.4m for 2024 and 2025. Government has now agreed that LPT Baselines in 2026 be further increased from €428.4m to €470.4m; in line with the Government Agreement of 26th March last that any additional LPT generated as a result of the upcoming revaluation is to be retained by local authorities for discretionary spending.

As well as assisting local authorities to meet the costs of providing essential services, ensuring an increase in baseline funding to each local authority enables a level of flexibility and discretion for each authority to address priority resource demands arising.

LPT allocations for 2026 are set in line with the methodology whereby 100% of the estimated LPT yield is retained locally within the local authority area where it is collected.

Leitrim County Council's Baseline for 2026 is €10,656,315.

#### Equalisation,

As previously, all equalisation funding will be met by the Exchequer, to ensure that all authorities receive, at a minimum, an amount equivalent to their Baseline. The equalisation funding requirement will be based on the total expected level of LPT in each local authority area and will not be adjusted if the basic rate of LPT is varied.

Based on its shortfall position when expected 2026 LPT receipts are compared to the 2026 Baseline, Leitrim County Council will be in receipt of equalisation funding in 2026.

#### **Self-Funding**

The LPT allocation model for 2026 will also change from previous years for those authorities with a surplus LPT yield above their baseline, whereby those authorities shall now be entitled to retain an increased portion of that surplus (pre-variation) for their own use.

Those local authorities with a surplus LPT yield above their baseline, will have that surplus allocated in two ways:

- Part of the surplus, up to the equivalent of 31% (was 22.5% previously) of total expected LPT income (or the full amount of the surplus if that is less than 31%), can be used as additional income by local authorities for the authority's own use as part of their normal budgetary process; and that Government noted that any local authority who benefits from the move to 31% retention will be expected to use this additional funding towards urban regeneration programmes in their areas.
- The remainder of the surplus, if any, will then be available to the local authority
  to fund services in the housing and/or roads areas thereby replacing Central
  Government funding for some of these services. Authorities are expected to
  continue providing such services regardless of the changed approach to
  funding. Accordingly, all LPT collected locally will be spent on the provision of
  services in the local authority's area.
- The self-funding requirement will be based on the total expected level of LPT in each local authority area before any application of a local variation decision and will not be adjusted if the basic rate of LPT is varied.

Based on its shortfall position when expected 2026 LPT receipts are compared to the 2026 Baseline, Leitrim County Council will not be required to self-fund services in the Housing and/or Roads areas.

The specific detail of the level of Central Government Voted grants funding to be provided to local authorities is a matter that will be considered, as normal, as part of the Estimates process.

#### Provisional LPT allocation to Leitrim County Council in 2026

The LPT allocation for Leitrim County Council for 2026 (pending any decision to locally vary the basic rate) is €10,656,315. As a local authority where the expected 2026 LPT yield is less than the €10,656,315 Baseline, this allocation includes €8,511,357 equalisation funding in order to ensure that the allocation is at least matched to the Baseline.

Please refer to the table in **Appendix A**, which sets out the basis for the allocation.

#### **Variation**

Every local authority has the power to vary the basic rate of LPT by up to 15%. While recent changes to the LPT legislation will allow elected members to adjust the Local Adjustment Factor (LAF) upwards to a maximum of 25%; due to the timing of the legislation, commencement of this section will be delayed until the 2027 LPT liability year.

It should be noted that if a local authority decides to vary the LPT basic rate upwards in 2026; 100% of the resultant additional income will be available for the authorities' own use. Similarly, if an authority decides to vary the LPT basic rate downwards (by up to 15%) in 2026, the resultant loss in LPT income will be reflected in reduced LPT funding to the authority.

Local authorities are further reminded of their statutory obligations as set out in the Local Property Tax (Local Adjustment Factor) Regulations 2022 (S.I. 358 of 2022) which take account of relevant provisions in the Finance (Local Property Tax) Acts. These regulations provide the updated requirements for local authorities who may wish to vary their local property tax rates for a specified period, in accordance with section 20 of the Act.

Apart from the formal notification to the Minister of the passing of a resolution in accordance with the regulations, local authorities are requested, as a procedural matter, to confirm with the Department, the local adjustment factor (or the basic rate, as the case may be) that should apply for the 2026 LPT liability year, on or before 31 August 2025.

Previous guidance circular Fin 08/2014 and Fin 06/2022 also refers.
