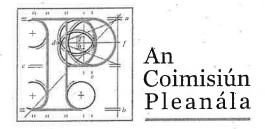

# Commission Order ABP-321148-24

Planning and Development Acts 2000, as amended

Planning Authority: Leitrim County Council

**Appeal** by Rosemary Úi Chonaill and Others care of Armstrong Planning Limited of 12 Clarinda Park North, Dun Laoghaire, County Dublin against the decision made on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2024 by Leitrim County Council to grant permission subject to conditions to GDM Construction Limited care of Francis Davitt Planning and Design Engineer of Main Street, Drumkeeran, County Leitrim for the proposed development.

Proposed Development: (a) Construct a total of 34 number residential units consisting of: (i) eight number two-bed, two-storey semi-detached, (ii) 10 number three-bed two-storey semi-detached, (iii) four number two-storey apartments blocks with a total of 16 number one-bed apartments; (b) construct a new site entrance off the existing estate road; and (c) construct car parking, landscaping, connections to all public services and all ancillary site works at Stonebridge Estate, Drumahaire/Drumlease, Dromahair, County Leitrim as revised by further public notices received by the planning authority on the 14th day of August, 2024, increasing the number of residential units to 36 and other works as part of the development including a new road network from the existing estate road, car parking, landscaping, connections to services and all associated site works.

## Decision

GRANT permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the said plans and particulars based on the reasons and considerations under and subject to the conditions set out below.

# **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the provisions of the Leitrim County Development Plan 2023-2029 including the zoning objectives for the site, the nature of the proposed development and the pattern of development in the area, it is considered that, subject to compliance with the conditions set out below, the proposed development would be acceptable and would not seriously injure the residential or visual amenities of the area, would not be prejudicial to public health or the environment and would not have significant transport or traffic impacts. The proposed residential development would be acceptable in terms of design, layout, scale and mix and would promote the appropriate and efficient development of housing on accessible and sustainable lands which would comply with the policies and provisions of the development plan insofar as they relate to residential development. The proposed development would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

While the Commission decision was largely in accordance with the recommendation of the Planning Inspector, the Commission did not agree with the Inspector's recommendation to grant permission for the new road layout, submitted with further information at application stage. The Commission was not satisfied that the additional road section would not interfere with the existing open space provided for the residential amenity of the Stonebridge Estate residents and considered that a cul de sac site layout without the said road connection would also provide a safer traffic and pedestrian environment for residents.

# Appropriate Assessment: Stage 1:

The Commission considered the documents submitted with the application, and all the other relevant submissions on file, and carried out an Appropriate Assessment screening exercise in relation to the potential effects of the proposed development on designated European sites. The Commission agreed with the screening assessment and conclusion carried out in the Inspector's Report that Lough Gill Special Area of Conservation (Site code 001976) is the only European Site in respect of which the proposed development has the potential to have a significant effect in view of the Conservation Objectives for the site and that Stage 2 Appropriate Assessment is, therefore, required.

# Appropriate Assessment: Stage 2:

The Commission considered the Natura Impact Statement and all other relevant submissions including expert submissions received and carried out an Appropriate Assessment of the implications of the proposed development on Lough Gill Special Area of Conservation (Site code 001976), in view of the site's conservation objectives. The Commission considered that the information before it was sufficient to undertake a complete assessment of all aspects of the proposed development in relation to the conservation objectives of the site using the best available scientific knowledge in the field. In completing the assessment, the Commission considered, in particular, the following:

- the likely direct and indirect impacts arising from the proposed development both individually or in combination with other plans or projects,
- (b) the mitigation measures which are included as part of the current proposal, and
- (c) the conservation objectives for the European Site.

In completing the Appropriate Assessment, the Commission accepted and adopted the Appropriate Assessment carried out in the Inspector's report in respect of the potential effects of the proposed development on the aforementioned European Site, having regard to the site's conservation objectives.

In overall conclusion, the Commission was satisfied that the proposed development, by itself or in combination with other plans or projects, would not adversely affect the integrity of the European Site in view of the conservation objectives for the site. This conclusion is based on a complete assessment of all aspects of the proposed project and there is no reasonable scientific doubt as to the absence of adverse effects.

## Conditions

1. The development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with the plans and particulars lodged with the application, as amended by further information submitted to the planning authority on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2024, except as may otherwise be required in order to comply with the following conditions. Where such conditions require details to be agreed with the planning authority, the developer shall agree such details in writing with the planning authority prior to commencement of development and the development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with the agreed particulars.

**Reason:** In the interest of clarity.

- 2. The proposed development shall be amended as follows:
  - (a) The glazing on the upper floor windows on the northeastern elevation only of the apartment building (containing unit numbers 17-20 as per submitted drawings), shall be manufactured opaque or frosted glass and shall be permanently maintained.
  - (b) The road section illustrated on Drawing Site Plan 23060\_P02 shall terminate after residential unit numbered 36 to the west and an area to facilitate vehicular turning movements shall be provided.

    The pedestrian footpath shall remain as illustrated.

Revised drawings showing compliance with these requirements shall be submitted to, and agreed with, the planning authority prior to the commencement of development

**Reason:** In the interest of residential amenity and traffic and pedestrian safety.

The mitigation measures contained in the submitted Natura Impact Statement (NIS) shall be implemented.

Reason: To protect the integrity of European Sites.

4. Details of the materials, colours and textures of all the external finishes to the proposed buildings (including bin stores and secure bicycle parking) shall be as submitted with the application, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity.

- 5. The site shall be landscaped in accordance with a comprehensive scheme of landscaping, details of which shall be updated and submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development. This scheme shall include the following:
  - (a) A plan to scale of not less than 1:500 showing -
    - (i) Existing trees, hedgerows, shrubs, rock outcroppings, stone walls, specifying which are proposed for retention as features of the site landscaping.
    - (ii) The measures to be put in place for the protection of these landscape features during the construction period.
    - (iii) The species, variety, number, size and locations of all proposed trees and shrubs, which shall comprise predominantly native species such as mountain ash, birch, willow, sycamore, pine, oak, hawthorn, holly, hazel, beech or alder, and which shall not include prunus species.
    - (iv) Details of screen planting and roadside/street planting, which shall not include prunus species.
    - (v) Hard landscaping works, specifying surfacing materials, furniture, play equipment, and finished levels.
    - (vi) Details of all play features to be incorporated to the public open space (such as the design, choice of equipment, safety surfacing and specifications and evidence that all equipment conforms to European Standards EN 1176-1-11 and EN 1177 'Playground Equipment and Surfacing').

- (b) Specifications for mounding, levelling, cultivation and other operations associated with plant and grass establishment.
- (c) A timescale for implementation, including details of phasing. All planting shall be adequately protected from damage until established. Any plants which die, are removed or become seriously damaged or diseased, within a period of five years from the completion of the development or until the development is taken in charge by the local authority, whichever is the sooner, shall be replaced within the next planting season with others of similar size and species, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the planning authority.

Reason: In the interest of residential and visual amenity.

6. A comprehensive boundary treatment scheme shall be submitted to and agreed in writing with the planning authority, prior to commencement of development. This scheme shall include the details of boundary treatments at the perimeter of the site and to the plot boundaries of each residential unit.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity.

7. Public lighting shall be provided in accordance with a scheme which shall be submitted to and agreed in writing with the planning authority prior to the commencement of development. The scheme shall contain all technical specifications for lights and columns and lighting along pedestrian routes through open spaces and shall take account of trees and landscaping. Such lighting shall be provided prior to the making available for occupation of any residential unit.

Reason: In the interest of amenity and public safety.

8. Prior to the commencement of development, the developer shall submit all drainage arrangements, including the attenuation and disposal of surface water for the written agreement of the planning authority for such works and services.

Reason: In the interest of public health and surface water management.

9. Prior to the commencement of development, the developer shall enter into a connection agreement with Uisce Éireann to provide for a service connection to the public water supply and wastewater collection network. All works shall comply with Uisce Éireann's Connection and Developer Services Standard Details and Code of Practice.

**Reason:** In the interest of public health and to ensure adequate water/wastewater facilities.

- 10. The construction of the development shall be managed in accordance with an updated Construction and Environmental Management Plan (CEMP), which shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with the planning authority prior to commencement of development. This plan shall incorporate details for the following:
  - (a) the location of the site and materials compound including areas identified for the storage of construction refuse;
  - (b) the location of areas for construction site offices and staff facilities;
  - (c) details of site security fencing and hoardings;
  - (d) details of on-site car parking facilities for site workers during the course of construction;
  - (e) details of the timing and routing of construction traffic to and from the construction site and associated directional signage, to include proposals to facilitate the delivery of abnormal loads to the site;
  - (f) measures to obviate queuing of construction traffic on the adjoining road network;
  - (g) measures to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on the public road network;
  - (h) alternative arrangements to be put in place for pedestrians and vehicles in the case of the closure of any public road or footpath during the course of site development works;
  - (i) details of appropriate mitigation measures for noise, dust and vibration, and monitoring of such levels;

- the containment of all construction-related fuel and oil within specially constructed bunds to ensure that fuel spillages are fully contained. Such bunds shall be roofed to exclude rainwater;
- (k) the off-site disposal of construction/demolition waste and details of how it is proposed to manage excavated soil;
- (I) the means to ensure that surface water run-off is controlled such that no silt or other pollutants enter local surface water sewers or drains;

A record of daily checks that the works are being undertaken in accordance with the Construction Management Plan shall be available for inspection by the planning authority.

**Reason:** In the interest of amenities, public health and safety and environmental protection.

11. Prior to the commencement of development, the developer or any agent acting on its behalf, shall prepare a Resource Waste Management Plan (RWMP) as set out in the Environmental Protection Agency's Best Practice Guidelines for the Preparation of Resource and Waste Management Plans for Construction and Demolition Projects (2021) including demonstration of proposals to adhere to best practice and protocols. The RWMP shall include specific proposals as to how the RWMP will be measured and monitored for effectiveness; these details shall be placed on the file and retained as part of the public record. The RWMP must be submitted to the planning authority for written agreement prior to the commencement of development. All records (including for waste and all resources) pursuant to the agreed RWMP shall be made available for inspection at the site office at all times.

Reason: In the interest of proper planning and sustainable development.

12. A plan containing details for the management of waste within the development, including the provision of facilities for the storage, separation and collection of the waste, and, in particular, recyclable materials and for the ongoing operation of these facilities for each residential unit shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority not later than three months from the date of commencement of the development. Thereafter, the waste shall be managed in accordance with the agreed plan.

**Reason:** In the interest of residential amenity, and to ensure the provision of adequate refuse storage.

13. The internal roads serving the proposed development, including turning bays, junctions, car parking and bicycle parking areas, footpaths, kerbs and finishes/materials/signs shall comply with the detailed standards of the planning authority for such road works, and shall comply, in all respects, with the standards set out in Design Manual for Urban Roads and Streets (DMURS). Details of same shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of amenity and of traffic and pedestrian safety.

14. All communal parking areas serving the residential units shall be provided with functional electric vehicle charging points. Details of how it is proposed to comply with the requirements of the Leitrim County Development Plan 2023-2029 in this regard shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of sustainable transport.

15. Site development and building works shall be carried out between the hours of 0700 to 1900 Mondays to Fridays inclusive, between 0800 to 1400 on Saturdays and not at all on Sundays and public holidays. Deviation from these times shall only be allowed in exceptional circumstances where prior written agreement has been received from the planning authority.

Reason: To safeguard the amenity of property in the vicinity.

16. Proposals for an estate/street name, house/apartment numbering scheme and associated signage shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development. Thereafter, all estate and street signs, and house/apartment numbers, shall be provided in accordance with the agreed scheme. The proposed name(s) shall be based on local historical or topographical features, or other alternatives acceptable to the planning authority. No advertisements/marketing signage relating to the name(s) of the development shall be erected until the developer has obtained the planning authority's written agreement to the proposed name(s).

**Reason:** In the interest of urban legibility and to ensure the use of locally appropriate placenames for new residential areas.

17. The communal open spaces, including hard and soft landscaping, car parking areas and access ways, communal refuse/bin storage, and all areas not intended to be taken in charge by the local authority, shall be maintained by a legally constituted management company. Details of the management company contract, and drawings/particulars describing the parts of the development for which the company would have responsibility, shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with the planning authority before any of the residential units are made available for occupation.

**Reason:** To provide for the satisfactory future maintenance of this development in the interest of residential amenity.

18. All service cables associated with the proposed development (such as electrical, telecommunications and communal television) shall be located underground. Ducting shall be provided by the developer to facilitate the provision of broadband infrastructure within the proposed development. All existing over ground cables shall be relocated underground as part of the site development works.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity.

- 19. Prior to the commencement of the development as permitted:
  - (a) The applicant or any person with an interest in the land shall enter into an agreement with the planning authority (such agreement must specify the number and location of each house), pursuant to Section 47 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, that restricts all relevant residential units permitted, to first occupation by individual purchasers, that is, those not being a corporate entity, and/or by those eligible for the occupation of social and/or affordable housing, including cost rental housing.

- (b) An agreement pursuant to Section 47 shall be applicable for the period of duration of the planning permission, except where after not less than two years from the date of completion of each specified housing unit, it is demonstrated to the satisfaction of the planning authority that it has not been possible to transact each of the residential units for use by individual purchasers and/or to those eligible for the occupation of social and/or affordable housing, including cost rental housing.
- (c) The determination of the planning authority as required in (b) shall be subject to receipt by the planning and housing authority of satisfactory documentary evidence from the applicant or any person with an interest in the land regarding the sales and marketing of the specified housing units, in which case the planning authority shall confirm in writing to the applicant or any person with an interest in the land that the Section 47 agreement has been terminated and that the requirement of this planning condition has been discharged in respect of each specified housing unit.

**Reason:** To restrict new housing development to use by persons of a particular class or description in order to ensure an adequate choice and supply of housing, including affordable housing, in the common good.

20. Prior to commencement of development, the applicant or other person with an interest in the land to which the application relates shall enter into an agreement in writing with the planning authority in relation to the provision of housing on lands in accordance with the requirements of section 94(4) and section 96(2) and 96(3) (b), (Part V) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, unless an exemption certificate has been granted under section 97 of the Act, as amended. Where such an agreement cannot be reached between the parties, the matter in dispute (other than a matter to which section 96(7) applies) shall be referred by the planning authority or any other prospective party to the agreement, to An Coimisiún Pleanála for determination.

**Reason:** To comply with the requirements of Part V of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and of the housing strategy in the development plan for the area.

21. Prior to commencement of development, the developer shall lodge with the planning authority a cash deposit, a bond of an insurance company, or other security to secure the provision and satisfactory completion and maintenance until taken in charge by the local authority of roads, footpaths, watermains, drains, public open space and other services required in connection with the development, coupled with an agreement empowering the local authority to apply such security or part thereof to the satisfactory completion or maintenance of any part of the development. The form and amount of the security shall be as agreed between the planning authority and the developer or, in default of agreement, shall be referred to An Coimisiún Pleanála for determination.

**Reason:** To ensure the satisfactory completion and maintenance of the development until taken in charge.

22. The developer shall pay to the planning authority a financial contribution in respect of public infrastructure and facilities benefiting development in the area of the planning authority that is provided or intended to be provided by or on behalf of the authority in accordance with the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme made under section 48 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. The contribution shall be paid prior to commencement of development or in such phased payments as the planning authority may facilitate and shall be subject to any applicable indexation provisions of the Scheme at the time of payment. Details of the application of the terms of the Scheme shall be agreed between the planning authority and the developer, or, in default of such agreement, the matter shall be referred to An Coimisiún Pleanála to determine the proper application of the terms of the Scheme.

Reason: It is a requirement of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, that a condition requiring a contribution in accordance with the Development Contribution Scheme made under section 48 of the Act be applied to the permission.
