I am the named keeper of my father's herd number. I hold a green certificate in Agriculture and am actively running the farm on a day-to-day basis.

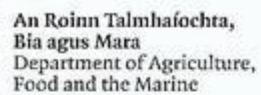
The proposed shed will be used to store farm machinery along with some vintage models to be completed to a standard sufficient as not to detract from our home which represents a lifetime investment.

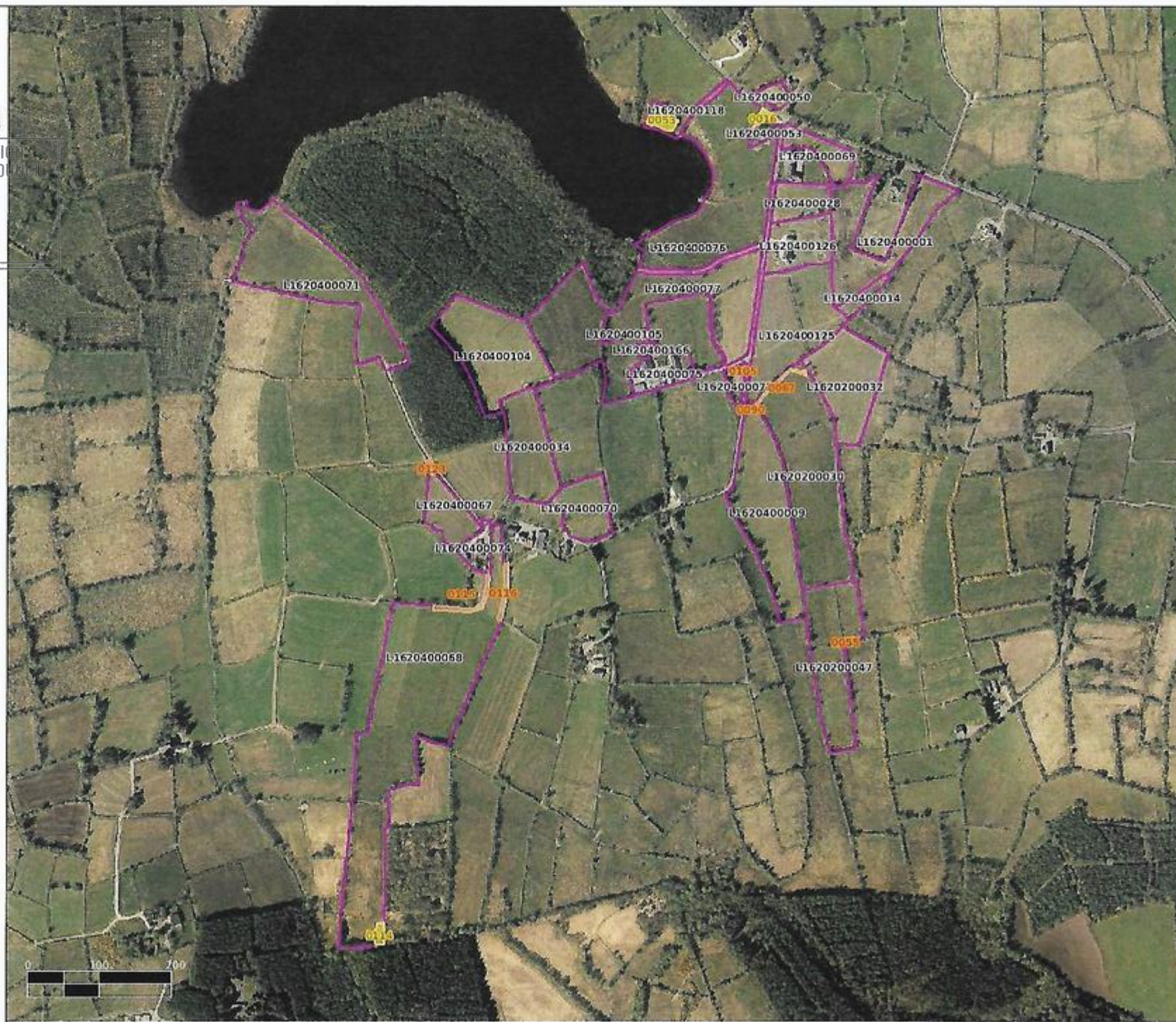

I am pleased to inform you that the application for a transfer of Owner and/or*Keeper is being granted for the herdnumber and herd designator quoted above.

Note: The above address, supplied on the ER1, is the address, to which all correspondence in relation to this herdnumber, including notification of any legal requirements, valuable or legal documents (such as animal passports) will issue, unless notification to the contrary is received in this Regional Veterinary Office (RVO).

Basic Payment Scheme: If you wish to record any changes to Basic Payment Scheme entitlements in connection with this transfer you can only do so through DAFM Online services or through a registered Agricultural Consultant.

I remind you that, taking account of the requirements of EU Directive 64/432 (Trading Directive) as amended, your continued entitlement to the herdnumber is conditional on your compliance with the conditions already advised to you and attached for your information.

Please note the following: -

- In any 12 month period acquiring and dispatching, more than 100 bovines or one or more sheep within 30 days, requires a dealer's licence.
- You should also be aware that full entitlement to compensation in the event of a disease breakdown is conditional on compliance with the conditions applicable to herdnumbers, with EU and national
