

CHIEF EXECUTIVES ORDER

Traffic Works Order

Active Travel Project 2026 – Clooncorick and Bredagh Townlands, Carrigallen, Co. Leitrim.

Leitrim County Council propose to upgrade existing facilities for vulnerable road users and ancillary elements such as improvements for pedestrians at Clooncorick and Bredagh Townlands, Co. Leitrim as part of its Active Travel initiatives.

Proposed Measures:

- 60m of two-way cycle track along existing laneway.
- 120m resurfacing / repair of existing mixed-use laneway.
- 180m of segregated pedestrian path along existing mixed-use laneway.
- 45m of repairs & widening of existing footpath along Eastern side of the L5592.
- 20m of repairs & widening to existing footpath along Western side of the L5592.
- 50m of new 2m wide footpath along the Western side of the L5592.
- Upgrade public lighting.
- Traffic Management.
- Provision of Road signage including advanced regulatory signage.
- Road safety improvements including drainage / installation of road gullies, pedestrian crossing point, segregation of road users and all associated site development works.

Legal Basis:

Under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 (as amended), Leitrim County Council is authorised to implement traffic calming measures on public roads for safety improvements. The proposed scheme aligns with these provisions as:

- It constitutes a traffic calming measure.
- The works will occur on public roads within the locality.
- No Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) or Appropriate Assessment (AA) is required.
- The works are exempt from the Part 8 Procedure.

All traffic signs for the works will be installed in accordance with Section 95 of the Road Traffic Act 1961.

Public Consultation:

The following non-statutory public consultation took place:

1. Website & Social Media

A notice of consultation was published on Leitrim County Councils Facebook and Instagram pages.

In addition, plans and particulars of the proposed scheme were made available on Leitrim County Council web page, <https://www.leitrim.ie/council/services/roads-and-transportation/active-travel/active-travel-section-38s/>

2. In Person

An in person consultation took place in the Community Centre in Carrigallen between 7pm and 9pm on the 18th of December 2025.

The deadline for receipt of submissions was **no later than 4.00 pm on the 6th January, 2026.**
